- **To understand the concept of “Access” (Frost & Reich. 2013)**

Learning Outcome :

The concept of “Access” consists of four elements, i.e. 1) availability, 2) affordability, 3) adoption and 4) architecture. (Frost & Reich. Harvard Univ Press, 2013, Japanese and Korean version available). Participants learn basic concept of “Access”. Then they obtain the way of thinking from wide various cases such as drug development for neglected diseases, compassionate use of drug, extremely high drug price, and newly introduced HTA system in Japan.
